"Every motion filed *shall* be accompanied by a brief stating the grounds upon which it is based, and a citation of authorities relied upon to support the motion. Within ten (10) days after receipt of a copy of a motion, opposing counsel *shall* prepare and file a response to the motion setting forth statements relied upon in opposition. * * * At any time after fourteen (14) days from the date of filing of the motion, the assigned judge may rule upon the motion."
