



**AC Case Management Meeting  
July 18, 2003**

1. Report of June 17, 2003, meeting accepted without change.
2. Standard Interrogatories. Several modifications were suggested and will be incorporated in the model to be separately supplied by both Plaintiffs counsel and Defense counsel within 10 days. Disc supplied to court will include changes ordered by court and agreed to at this meeting.
3. Dismissal/settlements. ABS settlement orders have still not been received. Are in progress.
4. Case Management Timetable. The second 50 cases were identified and July 18, 2003, becomes Day 1. These cases begin with AC 02 09 5171A, Phillips, Babcock Wilcox and end with AC 02 11 6365, Douglas, Daimler Chrysler. (See separate order)
5. Video Trial Testimony. The first Plaintiff trial testimony was recorded on July 17 at the Akron Law School. General satisfaction. Within 5 days of deliver of video to counsel and court parties will identify digital references to objections to be ruled upon by court; whereupon court will prepare final video of this segment of the trial.

Current issues include delivery of medical reports to Defense counsel in timely fashion.
